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`zweig.walk_preorder(tree)`

Yields the nodes in the *tree* in preorder.

`zweig.to_source(tree)`

Returns the Python source code representation of the *tree*.

`zweig.dump(node, annotate_fields=True, include_attributes=False)`

Like `ast.dump()` but with a more readable return value, making the output actually useful for debugging purposes.

`zweig.is_possible_target(node)`

Returns *True*, if the *node* could be a target for example in an assignment statement ignoring the expression contexts.

`zweig.set_target_contexts(node)`

Given a node that could be a target, sets the *.ctx* attribute to `ast.Store` instances as appropriate.
